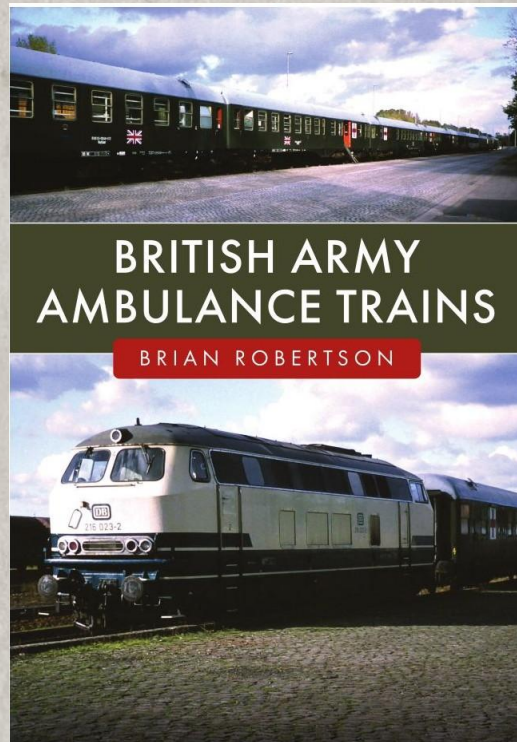




Forthcoming book by Col (retd) Brian Robertson L/RAMC

I am pleased to say that **British Army Ambulance Trains** is due to be published on 15th July 2025. This is a history that covers ambulance train use by, or on behalf of, the British Military from the Crimean War up to the end of the Cold War. It is being published by Amberley Books (www.amberley-books.com) and can be pre-ordered via their website.

Many of those who served in the Ambulance Train Squadron RAMC(V) or the Ambulance Train Group RAMC(V) will be interested to know that Brian has been working on another title **Ambulance Train Operating within the British Army of the Rhine 1979-1994**. This encompasses his 15 years involved with Ambulance Trains and will cover all we did in those latter years of the Cold War and detail what we did and where and how we did it. As everything to do with Ambulance Trains was disbanded in 1995 it will be a historic record as corporate memory is so easily lost.

Brian is also working on a more detailed look at **British Ambulance Train Rolling Stock since the Second World War**. He has a keen interest in Postal History to do with ambulance trains through all the campaigns where trains have been used. Hopefully this book may one day also reach into print.
