She worked for 30 years as a picture researcher and editor, and established and ran a picture library specialising in art and history, in particular military history, hence her interest and involvement with the National Army Museum where she was secretary of the Friends for 10 years.

She is a Blue Badge guide for London and also a City of London Guide and conducts tours and talks on a variety of topics around the capital.
