DATA PRIVACY NOTICE

Your personal data – what is it?

Personal data relates to a living individual who can be identified from that data. Identification can be by the information alone or in conjunction with any other information in the data controller's possession or likely to come into such possession. The processing of personal data is governed by the General Data Protection Regulation (the "GDPR").

Who are we?

FRIENDS OF MILLBANK is the data controller (contact details below). This means it decides how your personal data is processed and for what purposes.

How do we process your personal data?

FRIENDS OF MILLBANK complies with its obligations under the GDPR by keeping personal data up to date; by storing and destroying it securely; by not collecting or retaining excessive amounts of data; by protecting personal data from loss, misuse, unauthorised access and disclosure and by ensuring that appropriate technical measures are in place to protect personal data.

We use your personal data for the following purposes: -

- To administer membership records;
- To inform individuals of news, lectures or events run by FRIENDS OF MILLBANK and a small number of other organisations running similar lectures or events.

Sharing your personal data

Your personal data will be treated as strictly confidential and will be shared only with the Officers (typically the Chairman, Membership Secretary, Registrar, Treasurer and Webmaster) of FRIENDS OF MILLBANK. We will not share your data with third parties without your explicit consent.

How long do we keep your personal data?

We keep your personal data until you request to be removed from the FRIENDS OF MILLBANK mailing list or until such time as FRIENDS OF MILLBANK ceases to exist.

Your rights and your personal data

You have the following rights with respect to your personal data: -

- The right to request a copy of your personal data which FRIENDS OF MILLBANK holds about you;
- The right to request that the Officers of FRIENDS OF MILLBANK correct any personal data if it is found to be inaccurate or out of date;
- The right to request your personal data is erased where it is no longer necessary for FRIENDS OF MILLBANK to retain such data;
- The right to withdraw your consent to the processing at any time;
- The right, where there is a dispute in relation to the accuracy or processing of your personal data, to request a restriction is placed on further processing;
- The right to lodge a complaint with the Information Commissioner's Office.

Further processing

If we wish to use your personal data for a new purpose, not covered by this Data Privacy Notice, then we will provide you with a new notice explaining this new use prior to commencing the processing and setting out the relevant purposes and processing conditions. Where and whenever necessary, we will seek your prior consent to the new processing.
